

Purpose: The Medicine Hat Public Library is a place where valued works of art can be displayed on a long-term basis to enhance the cultural and informational resources of the Library.

1. The Library reserves the right to accept or reject any work of art in accordance with the criteria laid out in this policy:
 - 1.1. Donated works of art should be of special interest to the residents of Medicine Hat.
 - 1.2. Donated works of art must enhance the aesthetics of the library building.
2. The Library reserves the right to determine where and how works of art shall be displayed, but will respect the wishes of the donor where possible.
3. The name of the artist and the donor shall be suitably affixed to the art work.
4. While the Library respects the preferences of the donor, the Library reserves the right, at any time, to consider relocating a work of art to another public organization. Where possible, the donor or the donor's immediate family will be contacted for first right of refusal.
